## **Terms and conditions for Dr. P. D. Mistry Award for best Ph.D Thesis in Agricultural Meteorology**

1. It is hereby resolved that the Association of Agrometeorologists, India institutes an award titled “**Dr. P. D. Mistry Award for Best Ph.D Thesis in Agricultural Meteorology**” to be awarded annually out of the funds collected by the Department of Agricultural Meteorology, B. A. College of Agriculture, GAU, Anand and donated to the Association.
2. The award shall be restricted to the Ph.D. thesis in the subject of Agricultural Meteorology/Agricultural Physics (Meteorology) only.
3. The year of commencement of the award shall be the academic year 2003-2004.
4. The terms and conditions for the purposes of awarding this award shall be as under:

The title of the award shall be **Dr. P. D. Mistry Award for best Ph.D Thesis in Agricultural Meteorology**.

The award shall be presented to the winning student at the Annual General Body Meeting of the Association.

The year for purposes of announcing the award shall be the Academic year beginning with July 01 of a calendar year and ending with June 30 of the succeeding calendar year.

The student competing for the award shall have submitted his/her thesis during the academic year as specified above and shall have it accepted by the concerned University for purpose of award of Ph.D degree.

A thesis shall be adjudicated as the best from among those submitted for competing for the award by a committee comprising the Head of the Dept. of Agril. Meteorology, BA College of Agriculture, AAU, Anand as Chairman, the president of the Association as Vice-Chairman and two experts to be nominated by the Executive Council of the Association.

The Secretary of Association shall be responsible for conduct and execution of all the procedural activities such as making an announcement of the award, circulating the same to all the Agricultural Universities and other educational and research institutions operating an academic programme in Agricultural Meteorology/Agricultural Physics (Meteorology) in the country, launching procedures to constitute the adjudicating committee etc., well in time and on a regular basis.

Any student registered with any Agricultural University and/or academic/ research institution in the country (India) for a Ph.D. programme in Agril. Meteorology/Agril. Physics (Meteorology) shall be eligible for competing the award on acceptance of his/her thesis for the award of Ph.D. degree in Agril. Meteorology/Agril. Physics (Meteorology) by the concerned University/ Institution.

Only that thesis in Agril. Meteorology/Agril. Physics (Meteorology) shall be entitled for the award, which had not won any other award previously.

In case of tie among the winning students for the award, the highest OGPA secured by the student shall be the criterion for winning the award.

The award shall be in the form of a gold medal accompanied by an appropriate certificate signed by the President of the Association.

The award for a particular academic year shall stand cancelled if no thesis from among those submitted by the competitors has been adjudicated by the committee as worthy of award.

5. In the event of Association becoming non-functional or ceasing to exist for one reason or the other, the funds donated by the donor (Dept. of Agril. Meteorology, B.A. College of Agriculture, AAU, Anand) along with the principal and the interest accrued thereon shall be returned / transferred to the Head, Dept. of Agril. Meteorology, B.A. College of Agriculture, AAU, Anand by the Secretary / Treasurer of the defunct/ dissolved Association for any further action that he deems appropriate in consultation with his colleagues in the department.
