## **Terms and conditions for Prof. P.S.N. Sastry Award for best M.Sc. Thesis in Agricultural Meteorology**

It is hereby resolved that the Association of Agrometeorologists, India institutes an award titled “**Prof. P.S.N. Sastry Award for best M.Sc. Thesis in Agricultural Meteorology**” to be awarded annually out of the funds collected from the beloved students of Prof. PSN Sastry who have obtained their M.Sc./Ph.D. degree(s) from the Division of Agricultural Physics, IARI, New Delhi.

1. The award shall be restricted to the M.Sc. thesis in the disciplines of Agricultural Meteorology or, Agricultural Physics/Agronomy/Meteorology/Geophysics/Water Science (Specialization in Agricultural Meteorology) only.
2. The year of commencement of the award shall be the academic year 2008-2009.
3. The terms and conditions for the purposes of awarding this award shall be as under:

The title of the award shall be **Prof. P.S.N. Sastry Award for best M.Sc. Thesis in Agricultural Meteorology**.

The award will be presented to the winning student at the Annual General Body Meeting of the Association every year.

The year for purpose of announcing the award will be the Academic year beginning with July 01 of a calendar year and ending with June 30 of the succeeding calendar year.

The student competing for the award has to go through course curriculum plus thesis system during M.Sc. programme in one of the above mentioned disciplines. His/her thesis should have to be accepted for awarding M.Sc. degree by the concerned University/Institute. The date of final thesis viva-voce will be considered for deciding the academic year of the award.

A thesis will be adjudicated as the best among those submitted for competing for the award by a committee. The committee will comprise of the President of the Association as Chairman, both Vice Presidents as members and one expert to be nominated by the Executive Council of the Association.

The Secretary of Association will be responsible for conducting and execution of all the procedural activities such as making an announcement of the award, circulating the same to all the recognized agricultural universities and other educational and research institutions operating an academic programme in the above mentioned disciplines in the country, launching procedures to constitute the adjudicating committee etc., well in time and on a regular basis.

Any student registered with any recognized agricultural university / academic/ research institution in the country (India) for an M. Sc. programme in one of the above mentioned disciplines will be eligible for competing for the award on acceptance of his/her thesis by the concerned University/ Institution.

Only that thesis in Agricultural Meteorology or, Agricultural Physics/Agronomy /Meteorology/ Geophysics/Water Science (Specialization in Agricultural Meteorology) will be entitled for the award, which had not won any other award previously.

In case of any tie for the award, the highest OGPA/ percentage of marks securing student will be the winner of the award. A certificate will be required from the university/institute regarding conversion formula (if not mentioned in Grade Sheet) to convert OGPA to percentage.

The award shall be in the form of a gold medal and an award certificate signed by the President of the Association.

The award for a particular academic year shall be cancelled if the committee finds no thesis from the submitted ones by the competitors as worthy of award.
